DERINYA BASKETBALL INFORMATION 2018

TEAMS:

- For information on our team selection and club philosophy please go to our website – www.derinyabasketball.com.au

GAMES:

- Games are held on Saturday and can be scheduled at any of the following venues: Frankston Basketball Centre, 90 Bardia Ave, Seaford (opposite Kananook station); Elisabeth Murdoch College, 80 Warrandyte Rd, Langwarrin; Monterey Secondary College, Silvertop St, Frankston North; John Paul College, McMahons Rd, Frankston; Flinders College, 100 Ballarto Rd, Carrum Downs; and Bonbeach Stadium, Cannes Ave, Bonbeach.
- Games are scheduled between 8:30am and 7pm. Generally, U8's will be scheduled earliest, then U9's and so on.

UNIFORMS:

- Uniforms are compulsory and can be ordered on registration day at a cost of \$90.00 (EFT). To assist with child sizing, we will have some sample sizes on display. Some pre-loved uniforms may also be available for purchase. We are now starting to introduce (2017 forward) new reversible uniforms to our U8 (Prep & Grade 1) teams. Older age groups will continue using their yellow or blue uniforms.
- All uniforms purchased on registration day will need to be paid by EFT. Ordered uniforms can be paid by EFT within 3 days of the order. For EFT details see prior page. Please ensure you include in the reference field the child's name and 'UNI' indicating payment for uniforms.

TRAINING:

- Training is held at the Derinya Primary School, in the stadium. Our Training nights are Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Training nights will be determined by the Coach's availability and the availability of allocated times. There will be one 45 minute training session per week allocated for each team.
- *Team Managers must ensure that their team members wait in the stadium foyer until the start of their training timeslot. Players are not to enter the stadium and/or play on the courts/rings while other teams are training.
- *Please ensure your team's parents put away any chairs etc that they may have gotten out to use during training.

BASKETBALL SEASON:

- The first game is April 21, 2018. Generally, the first three rounds of competition will be played as grading matches.
- Finals are in September, with the Grand Final being played on the 22nd September 2018. There are no finals as such, for the Under 8 competition. Instead, they play scheduled matches upto and including September 22, with their last scheduled match classified as a 'Participation Final', with all players receiving a medallion after the match.
- A competition fixture for the entire season will be available on the FDBA website after round 3 of the season.

AT THE GAMES:

- All parents are required to help with scoring if they aren't involved with coaching or team managing. Team managers should create and distribute a scoring roster for their team.
- Court fees are to be paid prior to each match. U8-10 court fees are \$50 per match. U12 onwards court fees are \$55 per match. These fees are separate to the registration fee. These fees are to be divided up between families and are usually collected prior to the season commencement by the Team Manager, who then pays prior to each match. Frankston stadium will accept court fee payment via cash and EFT, however, all other stadiums require court fees to be paid in cash.

BALL SIZE / RING HEIGHT:

- Ball Size: Under 8's use size 5 balls / U 9's and older ages use size 6 balls
- Ring Heights: Under 8's use a lowered ring / Under 9's and older ages use the standard height ring.

2018 Team Managers Guide

As team manager you are a vital person to the Derinya Basketball Club. You provide the link between your team and the committee. There are a number of things you need to do for your team, to make sure the competition runs smoothly.

1. Keep a list of your players' names and their uniform numbers
2. Collect each week from your team the funds to cover the match fee. This is usually \$7-\$10 per player depending on the number of players in your team. You could choose for the parents to pay for all or part of their games at the beginning of the season and then you can pre-pay your games, which is done at the FDDB during business hours Monday to Friday. There is now a \$2 admin fee to process this however.
3. Organise a scoring roster for the parents in your team. If they can't make a week to score they can organise to swap with another parent.
4. Pass on information and emails from the DBC to your parents
5. Organise clash tops if your team is playing another team with a similar uniform (see below).

MATCH FEES: Winter 2018 season (U8-U10) - \$50 (U12-U16) - \$55

On Game Day

- Please arrive at least 10 minutes before the start of your game.
- Pay your team match fee at the uniform shop in the foyer. If you have pre-paid you still need to let them know that you are there.
- Make sure that there is a scorer. If you are wearing clash uniforms, the player numbers will need to be changed in the computerised scoring system. Scoring is now done on a computer and is very easy.
- Any new players to your team will need to be added to the computer before the match. You can ask the referees to help.
- Only add the players on the computer that are playing that day.

Clash Uniforms

- For grades 5 and 6 (old blue uniforms): The DBC have 3 sets of yellow uniforms for teams to borrow if there is a clash of colours with another team. The teams we will clash with are other Derinya teams, Ballam Park and Langwarrin Lazars. Woodlands are also very similar. If you are the **first named** team on the fixture you will need to change your tops. You can obtain the new tops from the Uniform Officer. The tops will need to be collected by the TM after the game, washed and returned. Alternatively, you may borrow a set of clash bibs from the stadium you are playing at. These will need to be returned after the conclusion of your match.
- For grades 2 - 4 (yellow uniforms). If you are the **first named** team on the fixture, you

will need to organise the clash tops. Blue uniforms are also available by contacting the Uniform Officer.

- For prep and grade 1 (reversible uniforms). You will need to reverse your top if there is a clash of colours and if you are the **first named team** on the fixture.

Forfeits

If your team cannot play for any reason, you will have to forfeit the match. All forfeits are penalised and the forfeiting team will be required to pay a fine equal to the sum of both teams' court fees for a notified forfeit (U8-U10) - \$100 (U12-U16) - \$110. If you do not notify the FDBA in advance of any forfeit, you will incur the standard forfeit fees plus an extra fee of \$40.

If the other team forfeits there is no fee for your team. If you know you will have to forfeit please ring the FDBA at least 24 hours prior to the game. You can call them on 9776 8999. Refer to the web site for more information under the Junior Competition Information tab.

Finding players so you don't need to forfeit

Please speak to either the President or the relevant Enrolment Officer if you are wanting to use a player from another team for your game to avoid a forfeit. Emergency players must be from a younger division, or at least two grades lower from the same age division (ie. An A grade team may borrow players from a C or lower grade team in the same age group). Playing an ineligible player will result in premiership point penalties. **Representative players must not be used as fill ins without prior consent from the FDBA.** You may only bring in extra players if your team has 4 or less regular players available. You may only bring in enough extra players to make up to 6 players.

Working with children check

Working with children checks (WWCC) are required in Victoria when working or volunteering to work with children. In the case of Derinya Basketball, a volunteer WWCC is required for the Coaches and Team managers of all teams. Your WWCC needs to be obtained by the 3rd game of the season. If your WWCC is not obtained you, will not be able to participate in your role until the check is done. The application form is available from the Website:

TRAINING IN THE DERINYA CENTRE

Welcome to Derinya Basketball Club for season 2018. We would like to extend a special mention to all the players, Coaches and Team Managers who will be joining us for the first time. We are looking forward to a great year of fun and excitement throughout the upcoming basketball season.

The following guidelines have been set to ensure that everyone involved with the Derinya Basketball Club enjoy safe and valuable training times in the stadium.

PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE DERINYA BASKETBALL CLUB HAS NO RIGHTS OR HOLD OVER THE DERINYA PRIMARY SCHOOL GYMNASIUM. IT IS THE SCHOOL'S PROPERTY. IT IS A PRIVILEGE AND BENEFIT THAT THE SCHOOL ALLOWS US TO USE THE STADIUM. AS SUCH WE SHOULD ENSURE THAT ALL CHILDREN, PLAYERS AND NON-PLAYERS BEHAVE AND TREAT THE STADIUM PROPERTY WITH THE SAME RESPECT THAT YOU WOULD TREAT YOUR OWN PROPERTY.

Coaches, Managers, players and parents should all make themselves familiar with and abide by these guidelines at all times.

1. Teams must be mindful of the fact that they are being allowed to use a valuable resource and will act in a responsible manner;
2. Teams must remain OUTSIDE the gym until their coach is present and until their allocated training timeslot. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. Parents must accompany players to and from the gym on training days. For their own safety children must not wander around the school grounds unaccompanied.
4. Coaches are to ensure that all players have been collected by parents before they leave. If parents are collecting other children please inform the coach of that fact.
5. Teams must vacate the stadium promptly at the end of their session to allow the next team to start their training session on time. If you are the last session of the day you must vacate the stadium on time to allow for other groups or cleaners.
6. Teams are not permitted to use any other equipment that may be in the gym.
7. There are both male and female toilets located in the building. Please ensure the toilets are left as clean as you find them.
8. Children who are not training are only permitted in the gym under the strict supervision of their parent or another adult.
9. Under NO circumstances is food or drink to be consumed in the stadium with the exception of

water.

10. There will be NO TRAINING on public holidays, school holidays, curriculum days AND on the last day of term. There are also other times during the school art show or disco that the stadium will be unavailable.

11. It is the responsibility of the coach of the last team for the day to ensure the stadium is locked up, the alarm is on and at least one set of lights are left on.

Minimum Age Coaching Policy

The Derinya Basketball Club has a minimum age coaching policy in order to protect players and coaches.

Coaches must be a minimum 15 years of age on the first day of the relevant season in order to coach. Any persons under the age of 15 are not permitted to coach.

The Derinya Basketball Club must be notified prior to the commencement of training and games that a person between the ages of 15 to 17 intends to take on the role of coach for each and any team(s).

If a person between the ages of 15 to 17 is undertaking the role of coach, there must also be a nominated person or persons over the age of 18 that must accompany the nominated coach at all training sessions, games and any other time of contact between coach and players. The Derinya Basketball Club must be notified of the nominated person(s) that will accompany the coach.

The nominated person or persons must comply with the FDBA Working with Children policy and hold a current Working with Children Check card. The Derinya Basketball Club must be notified of the number and expiry of the card. Please see Working with Children policy.

An older player cannot play down in a younger age group, e.g. U12 aged cannot play U10.

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BASKETBALL

Junior Competition Modified Match Rules

Mercy Rule – All Junior Competitions

- When team is leading by 20 points or more:
 - No Zone permitted
 - Must play behind the defensive 3pt line
- Mercy Rule ends if difference becomes 10 points or less
- Mercy Rule not applicable during Grading Matches

Representative (VJBL) Players – All Junior Competitions

- All teams must comply with 12 point cap
- Any teams that exceed 12 points must apply for consideration
- All Junior Blues players must play in correct age group
- Teams must obtain permission to use any representative players as fill ins

U8 Competition (mixed)

- Rings = Lowered height (8' 6" / 262cm)
- Match ball = Size 5
- No Zone defence permitted entire match
- No 3 point field goals
- Foul shots = Super short free throw line (*edge of circle*)
- No results posted
- Ladder without "Points For/Against" or "Percentage" posted

U9 Competition (mixed)

- No Zone defence permitted entire match
- No 3 point field goals
- Foul shots = Short free throw line (*94cm inside the 'normal' foul line*)

U10 Competition

- No Zone defence permitted in first half
- No 3 point field goals
- Foul shots = Short free throw line (*94cm inside the 'normal' foul line*)

U12 Competition

- No Zone defence permitted in first half
- 3 pointers = Shorter 3 point line (*where line marking is available*)
- Foul shots = Short free throw line (*94cm inside the 'normal' foul line*)

U14 Competition

- No Zone defence permitted in first half
- 3 pointers = Shorter 3 point line (*where line marking is available*)
- Foul shots = Normal free throw line

U16, U18 & U23 Competitions

- Zone defence permitted for entire match
- 3 pointers = Extended 3 point line
